Considerably more carefully crafted than your average slot car, this 1:32-scale replica of the Austro-Daimler Sascha features delightful details such as a rotating hand crank, knock-offs that actually knock off, and a tubby, moustachioed driver who is immediately recognisable as Sascha Kolowrat – the man after whom the zippy 1.1-litre Austro-Daimler was named. It's considerably more expensive than your average slot car, too, but you get what you pay for here.
